**Luc :** What do you mean?

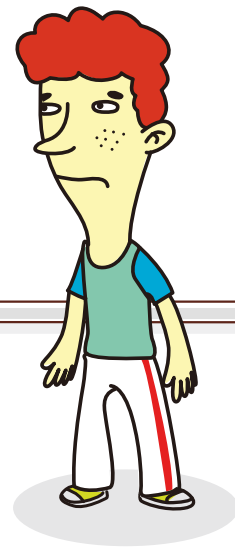
**Flora :** For example, San Francisco is a hilly city that still uses cable cars, but many other cities, like Tokyo, have elaborate subway systems.
